
IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS WITHOUT DEVICES AT HOME

The Ministry of Education has just requested that we allocate a school device to families who **do not** have a device that their children can share over the coming weeks to continue their learning programmes.

We are able to allocate **1 chromebook per family** without access to either a desktop computer, chromebook, laptop, ipad or tablet in their homes. We have a very limited opportunity to allocate these before the school is required to be locked down and all families required to stay in their homes.

Please help us make this as simple as possible.

Collection will only be available between 12noon-2pm tomorrow (Wednesday) from the staffroom deck.

- Only families without a device in their homes should come and collect a device
- A contract will need to be signed by the adult collecting the device - if the device is broken or damaged it must be returned to the school in it's damaged state following lockdown, if stolen a police report is required.
- Only 1 adult is to enter the school grounds for collection and the imposed 2metre distance from others will be enforced.

If you intend to collect a device please reply to this email with the following information:

Name of parent collecting the device
Students names and their learning team

We will have these devices already recorded and ready for handover when you arrive. If you do not reply then there may be a delay in allocating your device when you arrive.

INTERNET ACCESS

- Further information will be available to all families in the coming days about access to the internet for any families without internet access, sufficient data for their children to be using or other challenges. The first priority is ensuring all our families have a device in their homes before the school is locked down tomorrow afternoon.
